Alice Marie O'Brien (Mimi) of Depoe Bay, Oregon passed away on December 2, 2023 with her husband and daughters by her side.

Born in Cambridge MA on May 7, 1939, Mimi grew up in Belmont, MA. She was a 1961 graduate of Regis College in Weston Massachusetts and in 1965 received her Master's degree in Education from Boston College. Mimi started her career in elementary education in a four-room school house in Massachusetts. She then taught in her home town until she got married. Mimi taught in Arkansas where her husband was stationed in the Air Force. She moved with him to Montana, Alabama, Nebraska, and California. In California Mimi taught both students and teachers, and administrated school district programs until she retired. Mimi and her husband then moved to Depoe Bay. She loved ocean and river cruising. In retirement, Mimi continued her love of reading and stayed active volunteering as a board member for Neighbors for Kids, as a volunteer for many years at the Depoe Bay Crab Feed and Boat Show, and the Salmon Bake. Mimi was also involved with the Thursday Group at the Gleneden Beach Community Club.
