Allan Preece passed away from cancer, on January 11th at Samaritan Communities Hospital in Newport. Allan was born in Los Angeles, California to Jack and Virginia Preece. Allan served the United State Army as a Morse code operator in Italy for several years.

After the military, Allan returned to California. While he was working for Sears and Roebuck, he was blessed with his two children Jeffrey and Cari Preece. Allan Retired from Sears and Roebuck after 25 years as a computer programmer.

In the late 1980's, Allan's mother's health started to decline and he and Virginia went to live with Marilou and Gary Kesselring (Allan's sister and family). It was soon decided, Allan and Virginia would move to Newport for medical care and the Kesselring's would soon follow.
