Ann Hayden Chandler of Yachats, Oregon was born in Klamath Falls on June 19, 1935 to Elsie and Lyle Hayden. She attended school in Klamath Falls, John Day, and Dallas. She graduated from Grants Pass High School in 1953. She attended Oregon State University, and was a member of the Chi Omega sorority.

She met her husband Richard D. Chandler (Devon) at the Play House while serving as assistant to the director for Taming of the Shrew. They were married in September 1954, and were together for 63 years. She graduated from the University of Oregon in 1960 with a BS degree after having two children. Ann was employed as an accountant on the Cougar and Blue River Dam projects, and taught school at McKenzie River School District. She also taught school in Tabor, Alberta and in Missoula, Montana.

For many years, she owned and operated Chandler Gallery in Missoula, a fine art and Native American jewelry store. Ann was active in Business and Professional Women, Girl Scouts, and was very supportive of Women's rights.

Retiring in Yachats, she served on the Public Works Committee for 16 years and was a member on the Lincoln County Solid Waste Advisory committee.
