Dave enjoyed the last 5 years of his captain's career working alongside his son, Spencer Richcreek, a deckhand on the F/V Raven. Dave was a huge Oregon Ducks fan and held season tickets for 20 years where he and his sons shared a love for college football. Dave & Angie recently completed building their dream house in Sisters, OR where they spent time hiking, biking, floating the river, and hosting friends and family. active member of the Nazarene church where he spent many years attending & volunteering his time.

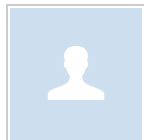
