



Eleanor "Ellie" A LeMaster

March 5, 1944 - March 17, 2026

Eleanor "Ellie" Ann LeMaster passed away in Newport, Oregon on March 17, 2026 at the age of 82. Ellie, the fourth of five children, was born to Everett and Edna (Quail) LeMaster on March 5, 1944, in Newport.

Ellie graduated from Newport High School in 1962. She attended Northwest Nazarene College in Nampa, Idaho, obtaining bachelor's and master's degrees in education. Ellie was a dedicated teacher and coach at Kuna Middle School in Idaho for 33 years. She taught health, science, and PE as well as coaching girls' volleyball, basketball and track. Ellie provided extra support to many students by participating on the school's Care Team.

Following Ellie's retirement, she spent time living in Port Orford, Oregon and ultimately returned to Newport, where she became a beloved neighbor to many in the Longview Hills 55+ community. Ellie served as a volunteer with the Newport Police Department, was a CERT team member, belonged to the Longview Hills Fishing Club, and served as a friend and helper to countless community members over the years.

Ellie is survived by her sister Vicki Courtright, along with sister-in-law Margie LeMaster and four nephews and their families. Ellie was preceded in death by her father, mother, step-father L.K. Pearson, along with brothers Wayne, Louis, and Bill.

A gathering to celebrate Ellie's life is planned on May 2, 2026 at the Longview Hills Clubhouse in Newport from 1:00 – 3:00 pm. Interment will be in the family plot at Eureka Cemetery in Newport.
