



## Elizabeth "Lily" T Ebreck

March 13, 1930 - February 7, 2016

Elizabeth T. "Lily" Ebreck, of Toledo, dedicated wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother, passed away peacefully at her home Sunday, February 7, 2016. She was 85 years old.

Lily was born on March 13, 1930, to Henry Steenkolk and Maria "Mary" Steenkolk. She was the third of 11 children and was raised on the Steenkolk family farm on Mill Creek near Toledo. Lily had many fond memories of her childhood, which included traveling to church every week by rowboat, picking blackberries to sell in town, swimming in the Yaquina River, and lots of time working together as a family.

After graduating from Toledo High School in 1948, Lily worked at the courthouse in Toledo. On April 20, 1952, she wed Orville "Jack" Ebreck in the Toledo Catholic Church, and they were married for almost 60 years until his passing in 2012. Together they raised two children: Gary and Tami.

Lily's professional life was spent working in data processing: first at Georgia-Pacific, and then at the Central Lincoln PUD, where she oversaw the IBM mainframe computer for all PUD district offices. Lily retired in 1995 after more than 30 years of service.

Lily's true joys in life were her faith and her family. In addition to spending time

with her children, grandchildren, and extended family, she enjoyed gardening, canning, cooking and baking, and creating scrapbooks of family photos.

Lily was preceded in death by her husband, Jack Ebreck; her parents, Henry and Mary Steenkolk; her brothers: Henry and Charles Steenkolk; and her sister, Mary Everett Miller. She is survived by her son, Gary (Julie) Ebreck; her daughter Tami (Mark) Ritacco; her grandchildren: Andrea (Shelly) Nelson, Jacki Ritacco, and Jacob Ritacco; and her great-grandson Christopher Nelson. She is also survived by her brothers: George, Joseph, Robert, Edward and Richard Steenkolk; her sister Helen McCanna; and many nieces and nephews.

A celebration mass will be held at 1 p.m. on Saturday, March 12, at Sacred Heart Church in Newport. A reception will follow in the church hall. In lieu of flowers, donations may be made to the American Heart Association.
