They married 11/18/47 in Santa Fe, New Mexico. They remained happily married until his untimely death 9/18/93. They first lived in Lamar, Colo, moving to Scio, Or. in 1951, then moving to Toledo in 1959. Here, they raised

five kids, she worked part time at the Lincoln Leader Newspaper, made wedding and birthday cakes also making hand sewn quilts that she always gave away or donated. She was a Lady Elk for 60 years, a member of the Olalla Ladies Golf Club, bowled on two bowling leagues, volunteered at the Aquarium for 20 years, a member of TOPS, a monthly Bunko group and played penguin every Friday.
