July 1, 1926 - July 27, 2016

Flora Mae Jincks, age 90, passed away on July 27, 2016. Born July 1, 1926 to George and Laurel Chandler, Flora grew up on the family farm in Peoria, Oregon, where she learned to garden and milk cows, and rode her horse to school every day. Flora said the first thing she learned to drive was a horse drawn wagon, the next was her Model A Ford.

Flora graduated from High School in Halsey, Oregon during WW2. She went on to complete her nursing studies, graduating from Emanuel Hospital as a Registered Nurse. On July 28, 1948, she married Arthur Jincks when he returned from active duty in Europe. Flora worked at Salem Hospital in Salem, Oregon, until the family moved to Newport in 1963 and she then worked at Pacific Communities Hospital in Newport.

Flora was preceded in death by her husband Arthur in 2013, her son Larry (lost in a commercial fishing accident) in 1979, and her brother Richard in 2012. She is survived by her brother Ellison Chandler of Washington; sister Marilyn Chandler of Missouri; and sons: Rodger (Linda) Jincks of LaPine, Leland (Jane) Jincks of Newport, and David (Connie) Jincks of Newport. She also leaves six grandchildren: Sarah Jincks, Amy Jincks, David Jincks, Michael Jincks, Lyle Jincks and Larry Jincks; and six great-grandchildren: Emma, Grace, Lucas, and Natalie Paranto, Jackson Wheeler, and Hailey Jincks.

Flora was a very special woman, greatly loved by her siblings, children, grandchildren, and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and friends. A Celebration of Life in her honor will be held at the American Legion on Saturday, September 10, at 2:30 p.m. in Newport.
