He then moved to the Oregon coast and built the home he lived in, within the secluded woods that he so enjoyed. In the late 1980's, he co owned "Graybeards", which was a well known crab and fishing store in old town Waldport, after which he settled back into a quiet life of retirement in Waldport.

Gordie thoroughly enjoyed shooting & reloading, reading, chatting with his neighbors and his daily walk to the mailbox with his dog, BD. Lincoln County will always be blessed due to his generous donations to the health care community there.
