Helen Margaret Jones, 92, of Newport, Oregon passed away peacefully at her home on February 15, 2016. She was the only child of Dr. & Mrs. Floyd Kimbell of Riverside, California.

After graduating from high school, Helen studied journalism and graduated from Woodbury University cum laude (with honors).

She returned to Riverside while WWII was underway and felt a duty to her country. She served in the United States Navy for 3 years in the WAVES (Women Accepted for Volunteer Emergency Service). Following her Honorable Discharge she again returned to Riverside where she met and married Walter (Mott) Jones in September 1948.

Mott retired as the Asst. Treasurer of the Edison Company and he and Helen moved to Newport in 1980. They immediately began to give to the community through their volunteer work with the local hospital and library. They were members of the Presbyterian Church.

Helen felt blessed to have traveled to several foreign countries with Mott. She liked to read on rainy days and worked out in her yard whenever the weather allowed.

Mott preceded Helen in death in November 2010.

She is survived by their son Craig Kimbell Jones of Newport, 4 grandchildren and 1 great grandson.
