Patrick McCay was born on March 21st, 1946 in Indianapolis, Indiana to George and D. Catherine McCay. He completed his high school degree and went on to some college, then served in Vietnam in the United States Marines. After the service, Patrick worked in commercial construction. During his life, he moved to Waldport, Oregon where he lived with his wife Sarah. On July 24th, 2016 Patrick passed away. Patrick M. McCay, 70, passed away at home due to heart disease.
