



## Sidney Howard Neal

December 27, 1919 - September 3, 2015

Sidney Howard Neal, son of Frederick Miles Neal and Virginia Artelia (Daniel) Neal was born at home outside Monument, Oregon December 27, 1919. He died at home in Toledo, Oregon on September 3, 2015. Sid grew up in the Toledo area and attended Toledo High School. He served as an Engineer in the Merchant Marines throughout World War II, circumnavigating the globe three times. He married Melissa Jane Snyder in Portland, Oregon on September 12, 1944.

After World War II, he returned to the central Oregon coast with his young family where, with his wife, he was store owner/operator in the grocery business, contributing to the civic life of Lincoln County.

Using brick and slate salvaged from the old train station in Toledo, Sid, his wife and family built the house where he resided for the last half century. He also maintained a home base near Long Creek, Oregon, where he enjoyed visiting and hunting with nearby family.

Warm and social by nature, Sid enjoyed fishing, hunting, gardening, golfing, playing cards and almost any activity that included family and friends. He was known for a green thumb and enjoyed success, especially with apples and, rare for the central coast, peaches.

He is survived by his wife of 71 years, Melissa, and his children, Linda Kendig (Doug), Cheryl Neal (Mike Hartnett, deceased), David Neal and their families.
