It is with sad heart that we share the passing of Twylla Hoch, age 83, on November 24, 2021. Twy was born March 22, 1938, at the old hospital on the hill, in Waldport, Oregon, to Walter and Florence (Payne) Hallowell. Twylla was preceded in death by her parents Walter and Florence Hallowell. She is survived by her husband of 65 years, Charles Hoch. Twy was a 4-H leader to many, including her Children and Grandchildren. She helped yearly with the Lincoln County Fair and was the winner of the Lincoln County Fair Homemaker of the Year multiple times. She was very involved with Home Extension. She volunteered many hours in the Home Economics class at Waldport High School and was always on board to be a chaperone for

her Grandchildren's school functions and field trips. Twy took quilt making classes, then shared her learned knowledge with hundreds in Waldport for many years. Her LOVE of quilting was EXTREME... she loved her Fridays at Bayshore, quilting with cherished friends, being a member of the Oregon Coastal Quilters Guild, taking part in the Guilds annual quilt shows, creating and presenting Veterans quilts, trips to Sister's, Oregon for the quilt show and classes. Traveling to Bandon and Silverton, Oregon for group quilting and traveling as far as Paducah, Kentucky for the annual quilt show.
